“Happy to note that NAMUGONGO MODEL PRIMARY SCHOOL is focused on promotional, competition and participatory updates of the Early Child Development programmes in Africa” says Prophet Patrick Donald.

Under the Educational package, NAMUGONGO MODEL PRIMARY SCHOOL has items not limited to the identification of young talents, involvement of parents in child education; National/International programmes, creativity platforms and motivational techniques for both teachers and learners.

The school was established by a group of nine (9) Ugandan teachers, determined to promote and protect the image of teaching profession in Uganda and beyond.

THE ESTABLISHMENT

NAMUGONGO MODEL PRIMARY SCHOOL was established in 2006, referred to as NAMUGONGO MODEL NURSERY & PRIMARY SCHOOL 2006 LIMITED. Combination of High demand for Early Child

Development facilities in Kira Municipality, Wakiso District and rapidly changing technology - driven world; propelled a group of nine (9) Ugandan teachers to commit hard earned financial resources and scarce quality time towards the establishment of NAMUGONGO MODEL PRIMARY SCHOOL 2006 LIMITED.

The founding members contributed one million shillings (UGX 1,000,000/=) each, as start up fund.

The said fund was allotted to meet rental expenses, operational cost, among other vital requirements.

In 2010, NAMUGONGO MODEL PRIMARY SCHOOL, procured 2 acres of land (16 plots) with clean land titles. The school is now focused on property development; with one hundred million shillings (UGX 100,000,000) spent on the development of a modern classroom block and executive office units.

“We have work-in-progress. About UGX 300,000,000 is required for the completion of another modern school building” explains, MR. MUDAMBO MISAKI, the Headteacher.

The lead founder of NAMUGONGO MODEL PRIMARY SCHOOL, MR. MUDAMBO MISAKI co-founded the establishment with eight (8) willing professional teachers, namely: MR. BIKINO SAM, MS. NEEZA JANE, MS. KANGAWO EVE, MS. AYAAH ALICE, MR. SSEKABIRA JOHN, MR KIBUUNGA EDWARD, MS. NAKAYENGA JESCA, and MR. KYAMUKANGULA PAUL.

“We are united under the umbrella of shared professional focus on self reliance and durable innovations” explains, MR. MUDAMBO MISAKI.

The school has 25 professional teachers, over five hundred learners; fifteen support staff... among other visible human resources.

NAMUGONGO MODEL PRIMARY SCHOOL proudly associates with MS. LARA LAMBERT, an English friend, empowered to solicit funds for and on behalf of the school. Through MS. LARA LAMBERT, a total of eleven (11) underprivileged pupils benefit from international sponsorship scheme.
