MOTHER MARGARET NURSERY SCHOOL is located about 18 minutes walk from the famous Mandela National Stadium-Namboole in Uganda-Africa. It operates at a hired classroom block, with spacious three classrooms that comfortably accommodates; Baby, Middle and Top class (Children age between 3-5 years).

FORMATION:

In 2015, Mrs Eweu Margaret was employed by Caring Heart Academy; a school reportedly established by an Engineer who died in 2016. The demise of the school proprietor caused untimely stagnation and final shutdown of all school projects.

Mrs. Eweu Margaret was stranded with all the children but the community intervened by providing an alternative school address to accommodate the children. It was at this point that Mrs. Eweu Margaret developed the full mind of becoming a proprietor once again.

She curved a new name: MOTHER MARGARET NURSERY SCHOOL to propel existing and future school programs.

Additionally, the combination of high demand for early childhood development facilities and limited supply of such facilities in Wakiso district 2016, Low levels of Literacy, good government policies, community moral support and rapidly changing technology-driven world empowered Mrs. Eweu Margaret to commit hard earned resources and quality time towards the formation and establishment of MOTHER MARGARET NURSERY SCHOOL. She has been joined by a team of vibrant Nursery teachers ready to support, guide, embrace and serve the community.

UNIQUENESS:

The school handles every parent and child according to the situation at hand. Parents enjoy the opportunity to pay school fees by installment. English language is the only acceptable medium of instruction and every child is special. The school is focused on an equal opportunity service.

SCHOOL FACILITIES:

The school operates at a hired classroom block with space limited to about 100 pupils only. Given the increasing popularity of the Nursery school; the school could demand for a new address and spacious facilities.

THE SECURITY:

The school security is reasonably tight. Additionally, security was enhanced by the construction of a security gate and concrete walls.

INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS:

The school has no support or contact with international friends. Efforts are continuous to search, find and establish friendship data bank locally and globally.

POSITIVE CHALLENGE:

The school has lost about UGX.2, 000,000 in unpaid fees between 2016 and 2017. Some parents take too long to pay school fees.

THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY:

The school had a total of 27 learners by end of 2017. Three teachers and two (2) support staff. The school community is within cross-cutting communities from Africa and beyond.

SANITATION COVERAGE:

The school sanitation coverage is at about 70%. The facilities could improve once the school acquires own property.

POWER SUPPLY AND FUEL:

The school receives power from the National Grid. Charcoal stove is used for cooking.

SCHOOL INSPECTION:

The school is in contact with the District Inspectors; officials are about to visit and give guidance with focus on improved growth and development of the school.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

No interviews are encouraged to assess the young learners; but parents are required to fill health forms designed to ascertain the child's health. The school admits 3-5 years old.

CURRICULUM:

The school follows basic guidelines on Early Childhood Development. The activity prepares Young learners to excel once they cross to primary school, where National School syllabus covers a wide range of National, regional and International studies.

LEGAL STATUS:

The school is in the process of acquiring temporary permit in accordance with section 31/32 of the Uganda's Education Act 2008.

BRIEF ABOUT THE VISION BEARER:

Mrs.Eweu Margret was born on the 25th day of October, 1954, to the family of the Late Esangu Stephen and the late Angweno Norah of Ararak village, Kaberamaido District in Uganda-Africa. She got married to Mr.Simon Peter Eweu on the 2nd February, 1972 The husband, Mr.Simon Peter was employed by the Uganda Railways in the early days. The couple had two children (Male and Female) unfortunately the daughter, Apako Harriet (RIP) died on 14/10/2015. She was a famous Netballer, playing under the team of the Uganda Police force. She reportedly died of an acute kidney injury. Her demise came shortly after participation in the Sydney-Australia World cup 2015.

EDUCATION:

Mrs. Eweu Margret earned two relevant/powerful Nursery Teaching certificates from Uganda and Kenya.

The YMCA of Uganda issued her with a certificate on 25th November, 2005 under vocational training.

She also earned a two year certificate in Nursery teaching; Awarded by the Ministry of Co-operatives and Social Services Department of Community Development in Kakamega-Kenya in 1973-1975
