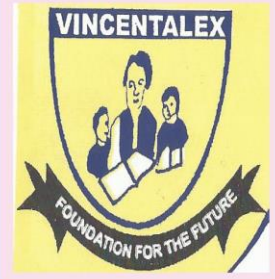

THE ESTABLISHMENT

VINCENTALEX BOARDING PRIMARY SCHOOL was established in the Republic of Uganda 1983. Combination of High demand for early child development facilities and short supplies of such facilities in Mukono district 1982, low levels of literacy, rapidly changing technology – driven world; propelled Mr. Matovu Vincent Ferrer Robinson (proprietor) to

commit hard earned financial resources and scarce quality time towards the establishment.

“True Love for humanity, urge to learn how a human being develops, provision of equal opportunity services, and focus on self-reliance were key motivational ingredients,” says, Mr. Vincent Matovu.F.R.

VINCENTALEX BOARDING PRIMARY SCHOOL ESTABLISHMENT was registered on the 7th day of November 1983, as a Private Nursery School /V.1 (PNS/V.1) processed by the Ministry of Education in Uganda.

According to Mr. Vincent Matovu F.R, the school opened in January 1994 as the first Boarding Private Nursery school in Uganda. The school had 184 learners and 12 staff members. It operated in hired premises at Seeta Trading Centre for four (4) years.

In 1988, the school paid off the current address. January 1991, the school upgraded to a Primary School by setting up primary one; then another class per every New Year: P.1 – 1991, P2 – 1992, P3 - 1993, P4 – 1994, P5 - 1995, P6 – 1996, P7 – 1997. (Full Primary School 1997).

“After this systematic and focussed development, the school registered with the Ministry of Education as a full Primary School – Private Boarding. PPS/V6, on 19th April, 1995,” explains Mr. Vincent Matovu .F.R

The full population of the school ranges between 600 and 650 maximum.

“Since 1997, we have had between 600 and 650 maximum number of learners enrolled per year”. Explains, Mr. Vincent Matovu.

VINCENTALEX BOARDING PRIMARY SCHOOL has strategic plan to remain as Primary School strictly. “We are focused on performing what we know and understand best. To put it right, loss of focus is the worst scourge affecting sections of school – establishments in Africa” Explains, Mr. Vincent Matovu.F.R.

VINCENTALEX BOARDING PRIMARY SCHOOL has maintained linkages with all former pupils of the school around the world.

“I don’t know how many graduations I have attended and how many professionals have passed through my hands,” says, Mr. Vincent Matovu F.R.

In witness of a complete enrollment cycle, former pupils support the school by bringing their own or other friends’ children.

“I am a proud grandfather. This school is now self reliant in terms of enrollment” . Explains, Mr. Vincent Matovu.F.R.

THE SCHOOL FEES STRUCTURE

on the 22nd day of January 1952, to the blessed family of the late Michael Lunninze Matovu and Maama Mary Nannyanzi Matovu of Kabuwoko, Masaka, Uganda – Africa.

Mr. Vincent Matovu .F.R has a string of academic qualifications obtained from Uganda and overseas.

His admirable life style is shaped by humility, patience, love, empathy, sympathy, tolerance among others. He is married with fourteen (14) children (five male and nine female).

He shakes wave of respect and honour at every walk to inspect educational activity within the school premises.

His down-to-earth lifestyle gives space for every one to appreciate the quality of leadership skills invested in him.

He is professionally soft spoken and has over 50% eye contact during interactive sessions. He speaks at the rate of about 25 words per minute. Above all, he is a mentor in many fields not limited to life skills and educational programs.

EXCITING AND WORST MOMENTS

The growth and development of VINCENTALEX BOARDING PRIMARY SCHOOL has been punctuated by segments of exciting moments.

“There are many events in my school that have been very interesting but let me note a few out of those.” Says, Mr. Vincent Matovu.F.R.

In 1994, 1995 and 1996 Mr. Vincent Matovu. F.R. took 120 pupils (by air) every year to Mombasa and back. The children represented Uganda during

music, dance drama and church choir competitions, under the Mombasa Children's Challenge Week. Other participants were children from Kenya, Tanzania, Zambia and Zanzibar.

"Each of these times, VINCENT ALEX BOARDING PRIMARY SCHOOL became overall champions and took the TROPHY for keeps," says, Mr. Vincent Matovu.F.R.

The air trips were sponsored by parents who also participated in departure and arrival welcome sessions.

"Out of such flights and exposure, one of our former pupils then is now a jet pilot in the USA" explains, Mr. Vincent Matovu.

However, the demise of his father (late Michael Lunninze Matovu) in March 1985, seals the tail end of worst moments in his life.

"My father passed on a week after I had made arrangements with him to visit VINCENTALEX BOARDING PRIMARY SCHOOL, but it did not come to pass," explains Mr. Vincent Matovu.F.R.
